



## Oxfam Musical Marathon 2026 Event Overview and Details

Oxfam Musical Marathon is the annual fundraising event organised by Oxfam Hong Kong. Every year, music lovers from different ages and backgrounds gather at shopping malls across Hong Kong to deliver a vibrant, non-stop relay of instrumental and vocal performances, joining hands to raise funds for those in need. In addition to the popular performance session, this year's event will feature a new competition element, encouraging participants to showcase their musical talents and creativity through solo, ensemble, or vocal performances. Contestants will compete for various awards, under the witness of professional judges and live audiences. We believe that music is a powerful force for positive change, with each performance giving a voice to the underprivileged and transforming support into tangible assistance. Funds raised from the event will be used to support Oxfam's long-term poverty alleviation projects in developing countries, helping people improve their lives and achieve self-reliance. The top ten in each category will proceed to the finals</li><li>➤ The finals will be judged by a professional panel based on participants' live performances, with a Champion, First Runner-up and Second Runner-up in each category</li></ul>
Performance Duration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Individual: Approximately 3 minutes per performance</li><li>➤ Group: Total duration calculated based on group size (about 3 minutes per person, e.g. a group of 10 will perform for about 30 minutes). The organiser reserves the right to adjust performance times according to the number of participants</li></ul>	Finalists must prepare a performance not exceeding 5 minutes

Outstanding Fundraising Award	Groups or individuals who have raised HK\$10,000 or more
Music for Life Award	The group with the highest average fundraising amount per member
