(1) Required documents

(2) Donations

Participants will need to contribute a minimum donation before enrolling in the event:

2. Event details

- 1. Event Information
 - Eligibility: Registered participants of OTR 2021.
 - Date: Sunday, 10 October Sunday, 17 October 2021
 - Venue: Runners are free to choose where they would like to complete the virtual run.

Runners can choose their own time (within the period mentioned) and place to complete the virtual run and choose one of the following 3 options (A , B or C) to complete the event.

Please note that participants are advised to put on their bibs during the virtual run. Upon completion, participants must take a screenshot of the virtual run results and collect their medals from the Macau Tower on 17 October.

<u>Full Race</u>	A. 61 Floors (183 m elevation) B. 10 km C. 14,289 steps*
	(The above options must be completed within one day)
<u>Half</u> <u>Race</u>	A. 31 Floors (93 m elevation) B. 5 km C. 7,000 steps
	(The above options must be completed within one day)
	The letters 'A', 'B' 'C' and 'D' will be printed on runners' bibs for the Team Relay Challenge to indicate the order in which each team member runs. The four runners must work together to complete one of the following options:
<u>Team Relay</u>	A. 61 Floors (183 m elevation) B. 10 km C. 14,289 steps*


4. How to record running distance





5. Special measures

We encourage participants to follow the following special measures in accordance with the Centre for Disease Control and Prevention's 'Special webpage against Epidemics':

- Perform hand hygiene frequently, especially before touching your mouth, nose 1. or eyes, after touching items/surfaces frequently touched by others (e.g. doorknobs), or when hands are contaminated by respiratory secretion after coughing or sneezing.
- 2. Wash hands with liquid soap and water, and rub for at least 20 seconds. Then rinse with water and dry. If hand washing facilities are not available, or when hands are not visibly soiled, use an alcohol-based hand rub with at least 70 to 80 per cent alcohol.
- 3. Cover your nose and mouth with tissue paper when sneezing or coughing. Do not spit or litter. If you must spit, please spit into a tissue. Dispose of the soiled tissues in a lidded rubbish bin and wash your hands thoroughly.
- Bring surgical masks, tissue paper and an alcohol-based hand sanitiser (with at 4. least 70 to 80 per cent alcohol) with you.
- If you have a fever or respiratory symptoms, do not participate in the event and 5. seek medical advice promptly.
- 6. Buy an insurance plan that covers COVID-19 if needed, and thoroughly read through the terms and conditions.
- 7. We will ensure crowd control when participants collect their medals. We will limit the number of visitors to 50 per cent or less than the capacity of the venue. The entrance will be closed to reduce crowds inside the Macau Tower. Participants will be asked to line up in an open area and will need to keep at least one arm's length away from others.
- Everyone who enters the venue to collect their medal should have their 8. temperature checked as they walk through the temperature detection area and present their Macau health code; our staff will also use handheld infrared thermometers when necessary.
- Masks and hand sanitizer will be provided at the entrance for participants to 9. use.
- 10. It is mandatory for participants and staff to wear masks throughout the medal



collection process at the venue. Please try to stay at least one metre apart 樂施會 from others to keep a safe distance.

- 11. If participants show COVID-19 symptoms, such as a fever, they may be asked to leave the venue.
- 12. If a large number of participants or staff show symptoms of COVID-19, we will notify the Centre for Disease Control and Prevention. For guidelines on the matter, please refer to: https://www.ssm.gov.mo/PreventCOVID-19.

6. Inclement weather arrangements

At 6 o'clock in the morning, if typhoon No. 8 signal or black rainstorm signal is hoisted, the medal collection event will be cancelled. Participants should pay attention to the announcement on event webpage and our Facebook page (Oxfam in Macau).
